



Furred For Fashion Style No. 6701—Shown on page 21

These directions are written for small size (32-34). Changes for medium size (36-38) and large size (40-42) are in parentheses.

MATERIALS

SPINNERIN Mosaic or Hilight (2 oz. balls) 12(13-14) balls

OR SPINNERIN Peruvia or Clu (2 oz. balls) 11(12-13) balls

OR SPINNERIN Mohair Boucle (50-gram balls) 11(12-13) balls

1 pair each knitting needles Nos. 9 and 10½

1 aluminum crochet hook Size "G"

3 buttons

Fur for trimming

GAUGE of Pattern Stitch:

4 sts = 1 inch 15 rows = 2 inches

BODY MEASUREMENT: At bustline 33(37-41) inches.

GARMENT MEASUREMENT: At bustline 35(39-43) inches.

PATTERN STITCH: Multiple of 4 sts.

Row 1 (right side): * K 3, with yarn at *back* sl 1 as if to P; repeat from * to end.

Row 2: With yarn at *front* sl 1 as if to P, K 3; repeat from * to end.

Row 3: K 1, * with yarn at *back* sl 1 as if to P, K 3; repeat from *. End last repeat K 2.

Row 4: K 2, * with yarn at *front* sl 1 as if to P, K 3; repeat from *. End last repeat K 1.

Repeat these 4 rows for pat stitch.

BACK: With smaller needles cast on 64(72-80) sts. Work in stockinette st (K 1 row, P 1 row) for 2 inches, end with a K row. K next row on wrong side for hemline. Change to larger needles. Work in pat st, inc 1 st each side every 4 inches 3 times. Work even on 70(78-86) sts until piece measures 16 inches above hemline, or desired length to underarms.

ARMHOLES: Bind off 1 st at beg of next 14(18-22) rows. Work even on 56(60-64) sts until armholes measure 7½(8-8½) inches.

SHOULDERS AND NECK: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 6 rows. There are 38(42-46) sts on needle. *Next Row:* Bind off 3 sts, work until there are 10(12-13) sts on needle. Tie in another ball of yarn, bind off the center 12(12-14) sts, work to end. Continue working on each side with a separate ball of yarn.

Next Row: Bind off 3 sts, work to end. There are 10(12-13) sts on each side. Continue to bind off 3 sts from each shoulder edge once, then bind off 3(5-3) sts 1(1-2) times **AND AT THE SAME TIME** bind off 2 sts from each neck edge twice.

POCKET LININGS: Make 2: With smaller needles cast on 20 sts. Work even in stockinette st for 3½ inches. End with a P row. Sl sts to a holder.

LEFT FRONT: With smaller needles cast on 40(44-48) sts. Work hem as on Back. Change to larger needles. Work in pat st, inc at underarm edge (beg of right side rows) as on back **AND AT THE SAME TIME** when front measures 5½ inches above hem, ending at front edge, work *Pocket Opening* as follows: Beg at front edge, work

16(18-20) sts, bind off the next 20 sts, work to end. *Join Pocket Lining* as follows: Work pat to opening, sl sts of 1 lining to left needle with K side of lining to wrong side of Front, work pat across sts of lining and sts on left needle. When incs are completed there will be 43(47-51) sts on needle. Work even until same length as Back to armholes.

ARMHOLE: Bind off 1 st from armhole edge every other row 7(9-11) times. Work even on 36(38-40) sts until armhole is same length as Back armhole. End at front edge. **NECK AND SHOULDER:** Bind off 12(12-13) sts from front edge once. Bind off 2 sts at neck edge *every row* 3 times **AND AT THE SAME TIME** Shape Shoulder as on Back when armhole is same length.

Mark place for 3 buttons on Front, having first marker 5 inches from lower edge, 3rd marker 7 inches from beg of neck shaping and other marker spaced evenly between these 2.

RIGHT FRONT: Work to correspond to Left Front, reversing all shaping and working buttonholes opposite markers as follows: Beg at front edge, work 4 sts, bind off next 6 sts, work to end. On the following row cast on 6 sts over the bound-off sts.

SLEEVES: With smaller needles cast on 36(36-40) sts. Work hem as on Back. Change to larger needles. Work in pat st, inc 1 st each side every 1 inch 12(14-14) times. Work even on 60(64-68) sts until Sleeve measures 16 inches above hem, or desired length to underarm. **CAP:** Bind off 1 st at beg of next 14(18-22) rows. Bind off remaining sts.

COLLAR: With larger needles cast on 64 sts for neck edge. Work in pat st, inc 1 st each side every 4th row 4 times. Work even on 72 sts until piece measures 3 inches. Dec 1 st each side every 4th row 4 times. Work 2 rows even. Bind off. Work 1 row of s c around collar, rounding corners.

LININGS FOR POCKET FLAPS: Make 2: With smaller needles cast on 20 sts. Work in stockinette st for 2 inches. Bind off.

FINISHING: Block each piece to measurements. Sew underarm, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves, matching shaping. Turn all hems to wrong side and tack in place. Overcast buttonholes. Sew on buttons. Cut fur trim for pocket flaps and Collar as shown in photograph. Line pocket flaps with knitted linings. With top edges of flap extending 1 inch above opening sew center of long edge of flap to top of pocket-opening. Repeat for 2nd pocket. Sew fur trim to Collar as shown in photograph. With center back of Collar at center back of neck and ends of Collar 1½ inches from front edges. Sew Collar to neck edge. Beg at end of Collar on Left Front and working from right side, work sl st on neck edge to corner, 3 sts at corner, continue sl st row on front edge to point opposite first buttonhole. Fasten off. Beg at lower edge of Left Front and working from wrong side, work sl st on edge as far as fur. Fasten off. Work sl st on Right Front to correspond. Turn fronts back to form lapels. Steam lapels and front edges.
